AYGF COMMEMORATES 16 DAYS OF ACTIVISM AGAINST GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE IN WOMEN 2023

This campaign was established by UN Women and was pioneered with the hashtag #16DaysOfActivism and #UNITE from 20th November, 2023 - 10th December ,2023.

Africa Youth Growth Foundation, in tandem with UN Women's UNITE to End Violence Against Women initiative, has launched a robust awareness campaign in support of the 16 Days of Activism against Sexual Violence Against Women.

UN Women's UNITE to End Violence Against Women initiative, a longstanding global effort launched in 2008, aims to prevent and eradicate violence against women and girls worldwide. Under the guidance of the UN Secretary-General, this initiative aligns with the civil society-led 16 Days of Activism against Gender-based Violence campaign, observed annually from 25 November to 10 December. The theme for this year's campaign is "UNITE! Invest to prevent violence against women and girls." Managed by UN Women, UNITE appeals to governments, civil society, women's organizations, youth, the private sector, media, and the UN system to unite against the pervasive global issue of violence against women and girls.

Responding to this urgent call, AYGF has swiftly initiated several impactful campaigns to amplify the message, urging citizens, global entities, media organizations, and relevant stakeholders both nationally and internationally to take decisive action in the fight against sexual violence targeting women. Our initiatives began with a sensitization campaign at Doveland International School, commemorating the World Day for the Prevention of and Healing from Child Sexual Exploitation, Abuse, and Violence.

We conducted informative sessions for children and teenagers of diverse age groups, addressing these critical issues and providing resources to mark the 16 Days of Activism against Gender-based Violence. Since the 25th, we have consistently engaged in daily social media posts, community outreach programs, and educational campaigns targeting students, citizens, and organiza-
